<b>COUNCIL MEMBER SEAT 1</b> Four Year Term (Vote for One)	<p>The project to be financed by the sale of the proposed bonds is the costs associated with repair of the structural, mechanical and electrical components of the dome covering the swimming pool, repair of the concrete piers, replacement of the insulation, repairs and upgrades to the heating and cooling systems, renovations of the liner, constructing ADA compliant amenities, installing sufficient water flow pumps and surge tanks, electrical upgrades and associated repairs and upgrades to increase the useful life of the swimming pool, and to allow for the installation of a new outdoors splash pad area at the pool complex for seasonal use during the summer months.</p>

The anticipated interest rate on the proposed bonds is 3.15% per annum based on current market rates. The total proposed principal amount to be repaid over the 20-year life of the bonds is \$5,000,000; the total interest anticipated to be paid over the life of the bonds, based on the anticipated interest rate, is \$2,027,107; the total amount to be repaid over the life of the bonds is \$7,027,107.</p>
